Who we are: The Friends of the Belen Public Library is an organization of volunteers dedicated to enhancing the programs and resources of the library. As Friends of the Library members, we lend our voice as library advocates, commit our time as volunteers, and support library programming and services through our financial resources. Friends of the Library members cherish and value our local library and believe the library is an indispensable part of the community.

What we do: Two book sales are held each year using the books donated by the public. In addition, the Friends of the Library have a "Book Nook" located in the library for anyone wishing to purchase books at minimal prices.

The library is facing economic challenges this year and we can all help out by donating to the Friends of the Library. The need for library services continues to grow, but the budget is shrinking. The financial support provided to the library by the Friends is crucial and provides funding for many popular programs for children and adults as well as purchasing new books and equipment for the library.

Where do your book donations go?

- Library collection If the book is in good condition and meets the library's selection policy, it may be added to the collection.
- Friends' Book Nook Books that the library chooses not to add to its collection but are in saleable condition are priced by Friends of the Library volunteers and placed in the Book Nook.
- Donated books are also sold twice a year through the Friends of the Library Book Sale.

FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY FALL BOOK SALE

The Friends biannual fall book sale will be held on October 7, 8 and 9, 2010. We have received many high quality donations since our April

sale, which will enable us to continue to price special books and collectibles individually, but still well below bookstore or Internet prices. Books for the general sale will be sorted by categories to help shoppers find subjects of particular interest. Considering library funding needs and the good value of books at our sales, the Friends of the Library Board recently voted to increase the price of a bag of books to support needed library projects. The new pricing structure is noted below.

- Thursday, October 7, 4:00 PM 7:30 PM
 - Open to Friends members only
 - Cost per bag of books will be \$3.00
- Friday, October 8, 10:00 AM 3 PM
 - Open to the public
 - Cost per bag of books will be \$2.00
- Saturday, October 9, 10:00 AM 3 PM
 - Open to the public
 - Cost per bag of books will be \$1.00

The book sale will be held in the lecture hall of the Belen Public Library, 333 Becker Avenue. You can renew and/or sign up for membership in the Friends of the Library at any time during the sales. Membership forms are also available at the library. Cost is \$5/person/year; \$8/family/year, and \$100 for a lifetime membership.
