ANNUAL BOOK SALE NEARS

It's already that time of year: the State Fair, roasting green chiles, the Balloon Fiesta, cool mornings, and the annual book sale put on by the Friends of the Library! This year's sale will be at Belen City Hall on Friday and Saturday, October 19 and 20. On Friday from 2 - 6 PM, members of the Friends of the Library will be treated to a private preview of the sale where they can purchase a bag of books for only \$1 and sample a variety of refreshments. Then Saturday from 9 AM - 2 PM the sale is open to the public. You can renew your membership in the Friends or become a new member at either sale.

The sale requires a great deal of time and effort to plan, set up, and run. YOU can

help! How? Buy books at the sale, of course, but also:

 Donate books! The Book Sale Committee is accepting donations of almost any kind of book, as well as CDs, DVDs, and videos. Children's books are desperately needed, but Readers Digest Condensed Books and most magazines are not. Just drop your book donations off at the library's "Bookstop" at the Recreation Center at 715 S. Main or arrange for pickup by calling the library at 864-7522 or Laura Hawes, Book Sale Chair, at 861-1925.

 Pick up the telephone! Help coordinate volunteers to pick-up donated books; move books to the sale site; and set-up, run, and take down the sale. To find out about this effort, call Laura at 861-1925.

 Assist with sale set-up! Help move books from storage at the Belen Consolidated Schools Support Services area on North Main to City Hall downtown, sort the books, and arrange them on tables. Call Laura at 861-1925.

Provide refreshments! Refreshments of any kind are welcomed. To donate, call Barbara Guenley, Refreshments Chair, at 861-2219.

 Assist with sale take-down! Postsale, any remaining books must be boxed and transported back to storage. Also, City Hall must be returned to its pre-sale state. Call Laura at 861-1925.

Much of the proceeds of the sale go toward children's reading programs. This summer more than 250 young people participated in the programs which included daily incentive prizes, performers such as clowns, a flea circus, and a magician, and end-of-program parties.

Special thanks go to Laura Hawes, Book Sale Chair, and her husband Don, for coordinating the sale for the second year. Also, thanks to Sally Garley, Belen City Manager, and Mayor Ronnie Torres for the use of City Hall during library construction. Belen Friends of the Library


